1 Corinthians 15

1 Cor 15:3: Christ died. He was buried.

1 Cor 15:4 He was raised

1 Cor 15:20 Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep

1 Cor 15:22-23 In Christ all will be made alive each in his own order: Christ – who is the firstfruits, afterward at His coming: those who belong to Christ.

1 Cor 15:25 How are the dead raised?

What kind of body will they have?

Job 14:14 If a man dies, shall he live again? All the days of my service I would wait, till my renewal should come.

1 Corinthians 15:42-44 What is sown is perishable; what is raised is imperishable. ⁴³ It is sown in dishonor; it is raised in glory. It is sown in weakness; it is raised in power. ⁴⁴ It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body.

1 Corinthians 15:51-52 ⁵¹ Behold! I tell you a mystery. We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed

Job 14:15 You would call, and I would answer you; you would long for the work of your hands.

1 Corinthians 15:52 ⁵² in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed.

1 Thessalonians 4:16-18 For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. ¹⁷ Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord. ¹⁸ Therefore encourage one another with these words.
