• Ps 89: Who in the skies is comparable to the Lord? Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne; Lovingkindness and truth go before you.

- Psalm 143:2: in Your sight no man living is righteous
- Proverbs 20:9: who can say, "I have cleansed my heart, I am pure from my sin?"
- Ecclesiastes 7:20: Surely there is not a righteous man on earth who does good and never sins.
  - Not righteous / a sinner / does not do good

- Romans 3:10: There is none righteous, no, not one; there is none who understands; there is none who seeks for God. All have all turned aside; together they have become useless; there is none who does good, there is not even one.
  - No one understands / none seek God / useless

- Romans 1:21: for even though they knew God, they did not honor Him as God or give thanks, but they became futile in their speculations, and their foolish heart was darkened.
  - Heart and mind affected by sin

- "because of their inability to do good and to escape from their fundamental rebellion against God and their fundamental preference for sin, unbelievers do not have the freedom in the most important sense of freedom that is, the freedom to do right, and to do what is pleasing to God."
