- * Yellow-green don't neglect your great salvation: don't drift away from the message of God. Hebrews 2:1-3
- *Yellow take great caution: don't doubt the word of God. Don't let there be a heart of unbelief in you. Hebrews 3:7-19
- *Orange Alert! Take extra caution don't be sluggish toward the word of God. Don't be spiritually apathetic or lazy. Hebrews 5:11-6:20
- *Red don't despise the word of God. Don't stand in willful disobedience to what He says. Hebrews 10:26-39
- *Red Extreme consequences. Don't defy God's Word. Lack of desire for God's word and lack of faith in God's word will result in painful discipline of the Lord. Hebrews 12:14-29
