## Malachi 4:4







Selah. <sup>3</sup> But Thou, O LORD, art a shield about me, My glory, and the One who lifts my head. <sup>4</sup> I was crying to the LORD with my voice, And He answered me from His holy mountain. Selah. <sup>5</sup> I lay down and slept; I awoke, for the LORD sustains me. <sup>6</sup> I will not be afraid of ten thousands of people Who have set themselves against me round about. <sup>7</sup> Arise, O LORD; save me, O my God! NAS **Psalm 5:11** *But let all who take refuge in Thee be glad, Let them ever sing for joy; And mayest Thou shelter them, That those who love Thy name may exult in Thee.*

NAS **Psalm 6:8** *Depart from me, all you who do iniquity, For the LORD has heard the voice of my weeping.* <sup>9</sup> *The LORD has heard my supplication, The LORD receives my prayer.* <sup>10</sup> *All my enemies shall be ashamed and greatly dismayed; They shall turn back, they shall suddenly be ashamed.*

NAS **Psalm 7:1** *A Shiggaion of David, which he sang to the LORD concerning Cush, a Benjamite. O Lord my God, in Thee I have taken refuge; Save me from all those who pursue me, and deliver me*
