

Psalm 19:7: The law of the Lord is perfect, restoring the soul.

- Perfect to be complete, whole, sufficient
- Restore: shuv to turn back
 - Spiritually to turn from evil and turn to good
- Torah (the teaching of the Lord) is sufficient to turn your souls from sin and turn them back to God.

Psalm 19:7: The testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple.

- Testimony declaration, statement of the Lord's will
- Sure established, faithful, dependable
- Simple naïve, immature
- God's word is reliable and shows us how to live God's way.

Psalm 19:8: The precepts of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart!

- Precepts -statutes, orders, rules, specific instructions that the Lord gives.
- Right yashar to be straight
- The rules of God lead us in the right direction and give us joy!

 Psalm 19:8 The commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes.

- Commandment definite, authoritative command
 - They have been revealed and are accessible
 - Deut 30:9-16 For this commandment which I command you today is not too difficult for you, nor is it out of reach. It is not in heaven, that you should say, 'Who will go up to heaven for us to get it for us and make us hear it, that we may observe it?' 13 "Nor is it beyond the sea, that you should say, 'Who will cross the sea for us to get it for us and make us hear it, that we may observe it?' 14 "But the word is very near you, in your mouth and in your heart, that you may observe it.

- Pure pure, clean, radiant
- The commandment of God is pure causing our eyes to shine.
 - Eccl 8:1 Wisdom brightens a man's face and changes its hard appearance.

 - 2 Timothy 3:16 All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; ¹⁷ that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.
 - 2 Peter 1:20 But know this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture is a matter of one's own interpretation, for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God.

- The Bible is a collection of 66 books written by 40 authors.
- **The Old Testament covers 3200 years from Adam to Malachi.
- *OT contains 39 books
- written in Hebrew (some of Daniel in Aramaic)
- written by at least 32 men
- *Between the OT and NT, there are 400 years of silence
- *The New Testament contains 27 books
 - written in Greek
 - written by 8 men

- 1.The Bible is inspired by God
- The Bible is authoritative because it is inspired by God.
 - To disbelieve anything in the Bible is to disbelieve God.
 - To disobey anything in the Bible is to disobey God.
- Matthew 4:4 Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.
- Psalm 119:4 You have laid down precepts that are to be fully obeyed.
- Psalm 119:21 You rebuke the proud -- the cursed, Who stray from Your commandments.

 - It always tells the truth
 - It always tells the truth concerning everything it talks about.
 - Psalm 12:6 The words of the LORD are pure words; As silver tried in a furnace on the earth, refined seven times.

NKJ 1 Corinthians 2:9 But as it is written: "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him." 10 But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God. 11 For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God. ¹² Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God. 13 These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual. 14 But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.



• Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.



• Psalm 19:12 Who can discern his errors? Acquit me of hidden faults. ¹³ Also keep back Thy servant from presumptuous sins; Let them not rule over me; Then I shall be blameless, And I shall be acquitted of great transgression. ¹⁴ Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart Be acceptable in Thy sight, O LORD, my rock and my Redeemer.
