  - Yahweh always deserves new songs!
  - Contrasts with “old, worldly” songs
  - New person sings a new song

- **Genesis 49:10** <sup>10</sup> "The scepter shall not depart from Judah, Nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, Until Shiloh comes, And to him *shall* be the obedience of the peoples.

  - › **Israel's** existence as a nation is because of the Lord's plan.
  - › What about the rest of the nations of the world? They too – have their existence because of the plan of the Lord.

- **Ps 33: 18-19: God's Dominion over Individuals**
- **Psalm 33:18-22**   <sup>18</sup> **Behold!** the eye of the LORD is on those who fear Him, On those who hope for His lovingkindness,  
<sup>19</sup> To deliver their soul from death, And to keep them alive in famine.
  - › Even if our nation does not submit to the Lord, the Lord knows who belongs to HIM.
