He who judges seeks out the wrongdoer to punish him, and seeks out the righteous to vindicate him. - Leon Morris, The Biblical Doctrine of Judgment

## GOD THE JUDGE

**Job 34:10-12** Far be it from God to do evil, from the Almighty to do wrong. <sup>11</sup> He repays a man for what he has done; he brings upon him what his conduct deserves. <sup>12</sup> It is unthinkable that God would do wrong, that the Almighty would pervert justice.

Psalm 99:1 – 4: The Lord reigns! The nations tremble. He sits enthroned above the cherubim, the earth shakes. The Lord is elevated in Zion; he is exalted over all the nations.... 

## The Good News of God's Judgment:

God set forth Christ as a **propitiation.**

This is the act of offering an appropriate sacrifice to **turn away  
the wrath of God.**

**Hebrews 2:17** Therefore he had to be made like his brothers in every respect, so that He might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.

# GOD THE JUDGE

## The Good News of God's Judgment:

This act of God the Judge *demonstrated His justice and also satisfied His requirement for justice.*

# GOD THE JUDGE

## 3 options regarding sinners:

#1: God can condemn them to eternal separation from Himself

#2: God can compromise His own righteousness to receive them in Heaven as they are

#3: God can change them into righteous people – able to be in His presence

# GOD THE JUDGE

*legally declares us...*

*on the basis of the blood of Christ...*

**RIGHTEOUS!**

*This is justification, the instantaneous legal act of God in which He thinks of our sins as forgiven and Christ's righteousness as belonging to us, and declares us to be righteous in His sight.*

## GOD THE JUDGE

**Romans 3:21-26** <sup>21</sup> But now apart from the Law the righteousness of God has been manifested, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, <sup>22</sup> even the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all those who believe; for there is no distinction; <sup>23</sup> for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, <sup>24</sup> being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus; <sup>25</sup> whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through faith. This was to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed; <sup>26</sup> for the demonstration, I say, of His righteousness at the present time, that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

#3: God can change them into righteous people – able

## GOD THE JUDGE

Our JUST God – makes us JUST like Christ.... He gives us the righteousness of Christ.

We receive this by faith

**Romans 4:5:** to the one who does not work, but believes in Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is reckoned as righteousness,

# GOD THE JUDGE

The Judge carried out the death sentence  
on the One **who was NOT guilty,**

and the guilty were **set free!**
