⁸ And the LORD God planted a garden toward the east, in Eden; and there He placed the man whom He had formed.

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⁹ And out of the ground the LORD God caused to grow every tree that is pleasing to the sight and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. ¹⁰ Now a river flowed out of Eden to water the garden; and from there it divided and became four rivers.

Psalm 11:4 ⁴ The LORD is in His holy temple; the LORD's throne is in heaven; His eyes behold, His eyelids test the sons of men.

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The Heavenly Temple

Exodus 25:40 ⁴⁰ "And see that you make *them* after the pattern for them, which was shown to you on the mountain.

- **Acts 7:44** Our ancestors had the tabernacle of testimony in the wilderness, just as God who spoke to Moses ordered him to make it according to the design he had seen.



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The Heavenly Temple

Hebrews 8:5 These serve as a copy and shadow of the heavenly things, as Moses was warned when he was about to complete the tabernacle. For He said, Be careful that you make everything according to the pattern that was shown to you on the mountain

The tabernacle in the wilderness and the temple on earth represented the unseen spiritual reality of God's holiness and sovereignty.

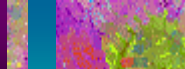

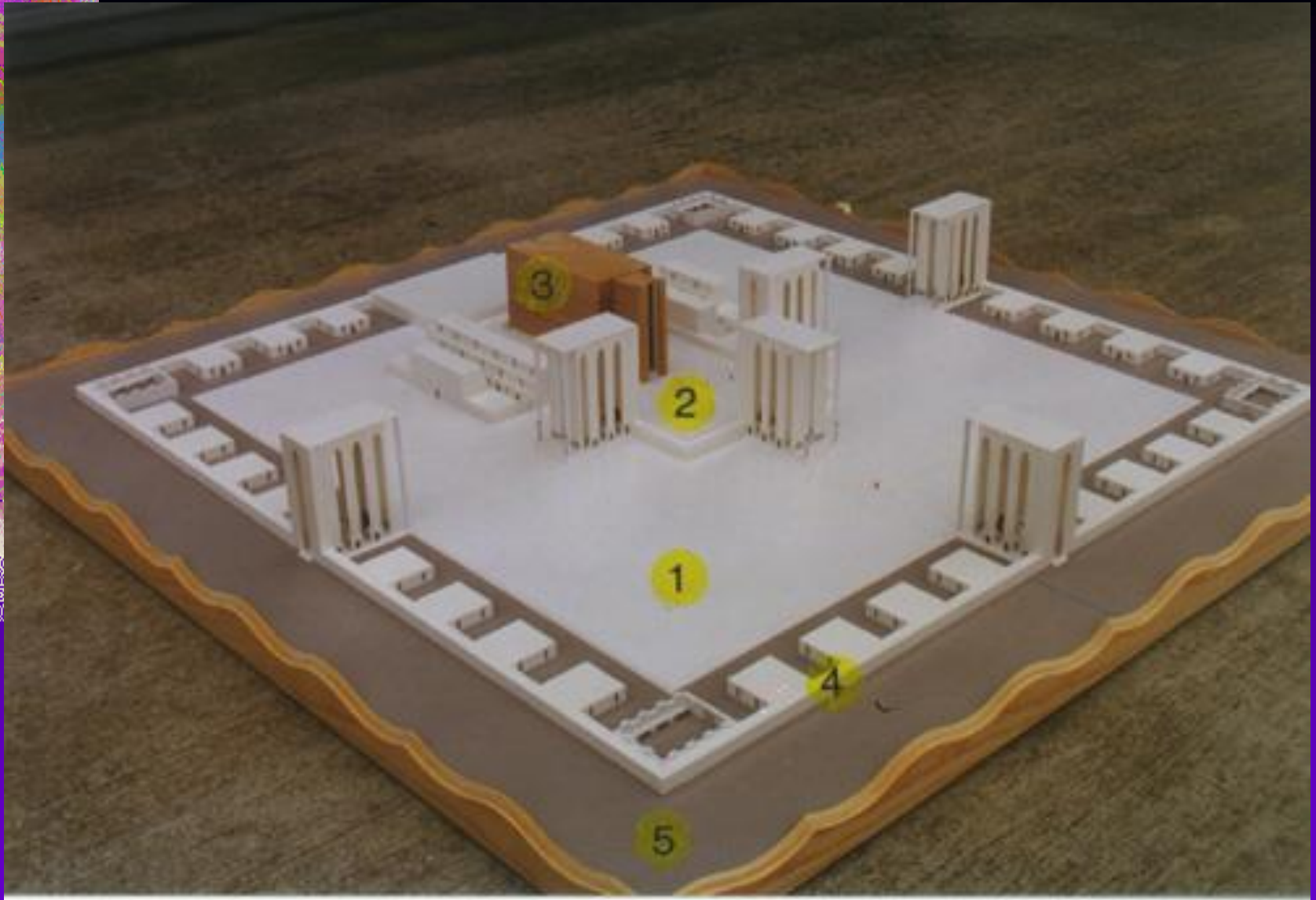
