## REVIEWING "THESE THINGS":

*Opening statement of Jesus' last message* – Jesus' began with a clear declaration of His \_\_\_\_\_ and His \_\_\_\_\_. John 13:31

A \_\_\_\_\_ contrast: "In the world you will have tribulation \_\_\_\_\_ be of good cheer." The conjunction in the Greek is: *alla* - presents a strong contrast between statements.

*Be of good cheer* - Be courageous! Take heart! Take courage! Why?

*I have overcome the world*

In His last days and hours on earth, before His death, Jesus was:
