# CAN THE DEAD LIVE AGAIN?

**Job 14** <sup>10</sup> But a man dies and is laid low; man breathes his last, and where is he? <sup>11</sup> As waters fail from a lake and a river wastes away and dries up, <sup>12</sup> so a man lies down and rises not again; till the heavens are no more he will not awake or be roused out of his sleep.

# CAN THE DEAD LIVE AGAIN?

Job 14:13 – 17 Oh that you would hide me in Sheol, that you would conceal me until your wrath be past, that you would appoint me a set time, and remember me! <sup>14</sup> If a man dies, shall he live again? All the days of my service I would wait, till my renewal should come. <sup>15</sup> You would call, and I would answer you; you would long for the work of your hands. <sup>16</sup> For then you would number my steps; you would not keep watch over my sin; <sup>17</sup> my transgression would be sealed up in a bag, and you would cover over my iniquity.

# CAN THE DEAD LIVE AGAIN?


**Job 14:15** *You would call, and I would answer you; you would long for the work of your hands.*

**1 Thessalonians 4:16-18** *For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. <sup>17</sup> Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord. <sup>18</sup> Therefore encourage one another with these words.*


# **CAN THE DEAD LIVE AGAIN?**




- SHEOL (Hebrew) = HADES (Greek)




