- **Job 34:12** Indeed, it is true that God does not act wickedly and the Almighty does not pervert justice.
- It is a logical **impossibility** for Him to do wrong. Our God who is perfect makes **no mistakes**.
- Shaddai – the Almighty - does not **abuse** His power.
