Jesus' Second Coming

Luke 1:31-33 And behold, you will conceive in your womb, and bear a son, and you ^ashall name Him Jesus. ³² "He will be great, and will be called the Son of ^athe Most High; and the Lord God will give Him ^bthe throne of His father David; ³³ ^aand He will reign over the house of Jacob forever; ^band His kingdom will have no end

The wise men asked: **Matthew 2:2** ² "Where is He who has been born ^aKing of the Jews? For we saw ^bHis star in the east, and have come to worship Him."

- The world is left unjudged
- Unbelievers remain on earth

2nd Coming

Rev 19:11-16

Dead OT saints resurrected when
after Jesus return to earth

Living believers remain mortal
on earth during the Millinnium

The world is judged

Believers remain on earth

Jesus' Second Coming

- **Rapture**
- **1 Thess 4:13-18**
- The world continues to sin
- Addresses only the saved
- Can happen at any moment
- No talk of Jesus as King on Earth
- Satan continues his evil reign

2nd Coming

Rev 19:11-16

Righteousness is established

Addresses the saved and the unsaved

many signs must first occur

Jesus returning as King of Kings, with the Kingdom being given to Him (Rev 11)

Satan is cast into the Abyss (demons are imprisoned in Babylon)

Jesus' Second Coming

Jesus is coming to judge the wicked, and give them what they deserve. Their sin and rebellion against God earns them death.

- **Revelation 19:11** ¹¹ And I saw ^aheaven opened; and behold, a ^bwhite horse, and He who sat upon it *is* called ^cFaithful and True; and in ^drighteousness He judges and wages war. **Revelation 19:15** ¹⁵ And ^afrom His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that ^bwith it He may smite the nations;
- **Revelation 19:19-21** ¹⁹ And I saw ^athe beast and ^bthe kings of the earth and their armies, assembled to make war against Him who ^csat upon the horse, and against His army. ²⁰ And the beast was seized, and with him the ^afalse prophet who ^bperformed the signs ^{1c}in his presence, by which he ^ddeceived those who had received the ^emark of the beast and those who ^fworshiped his image; these two were thrown alive into the ^glake of ^hfire which burns with brimstone. ²¹ And the rest were killed with the sword which ^acame from the mouth of Him who ^bsat upon the horse, and ^call the birds were filled with their flesh.

Jesus' Second Coming

Jesus has the right to return, and carry out retribution against the rebels.

- In the beginning – God gave Adam **the kingdom mandate**

Genesis 1:28 ²⁸ And God blessed them; and God said to them, ^a"Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it; and rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the ¹sky, and over every living thing that ²moves on the earth."

- “The kingdom mandate is God’s original commission for humanity to reflect God’s character and extend God’s rule and will across the earth.”

- Jesus is called the second Adam. And HE will do what Adam was supposed to do.

Jesus' Second Coming

- After the flood... The people once again were given a kingdom mandate.

Genesis 9:1 ^{NAS} **Genesis 9:1** And God blessed Noah and his sons and said to them, ^a"Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth.

Genesis 9:7 ⁷ "And as for you, ^abe fruitful and multiply; ¹Populate the earth abundantly and multiply in it."

- The tower of Babel is evidence that once again the people rejected God's kingdom mandate.

Jesus' Second Coming

- So God scattered the people and created nations.
- God gave the nations over to be ruled by spiritual forces.

^{NLT} **Deuteronomy 32:8** When the Most High assigned lands to the nations, when he divided up the human race, he established the boundaries of the peoples according to the number in his heavenly court.

Daniel 10:13-21

Ezekiel 28

Jesus' Second Coming

- Then God created the nation Israel – to be the nation / the people group that HE would rule over. He was KING over Israel. But they rejected God as their king, and told Samuel to get them a king – a human king like all the other nations had.
- Once again – the kingdom mandate – that God intended – for Israel to be His representative and carry out HIS Kingdom ways ... they did not do it.

Jesus' Second Coming

- The Lord to Israel:
- you are not going to have a king again until the one appears who has the right to judge the kingdom.... And I will give it to Him.
- **Ezekiel 21:26-27** ²⁶ This is what the Sovereign LORD says: "Take off your jeweled crown, for the old order changes. Now the lowly will be exalted, and the mighty will be brought down. ²⁷ Destruction! Destruction! I will surely destroy the kingdom. And it will not be restored until the one appears who has the right to judge it. Then I will hand it over to him.

Jesus' Second Coming

- Jesus is coming back.
- To judge.
- To receive the Kingdom and fulfill His Father's kingdom mandate.
- To rule over the earth – in righteousness.
- To reign in His majesty, and make the earth a wonderful , peaceable kingdom.

Jesus' Second Coming

- The day of vengeance. The day of judgment.
- **2 Thessalonians 2:8** ⁸ And then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord will consume with the breath of His mouth and destroy with the brightness of His coming.
- **Jesus will slay the Antichrist with the sword of His mouth, with the breath of His mouth.**

Jesus' Second Coming

- Jesus returns as judge of the wicked.
- to eradicate the rebels.
- to defeat all forces of evil that have ruled over the nations.
- To pay unrepentant sinners the wages of death that they are due.

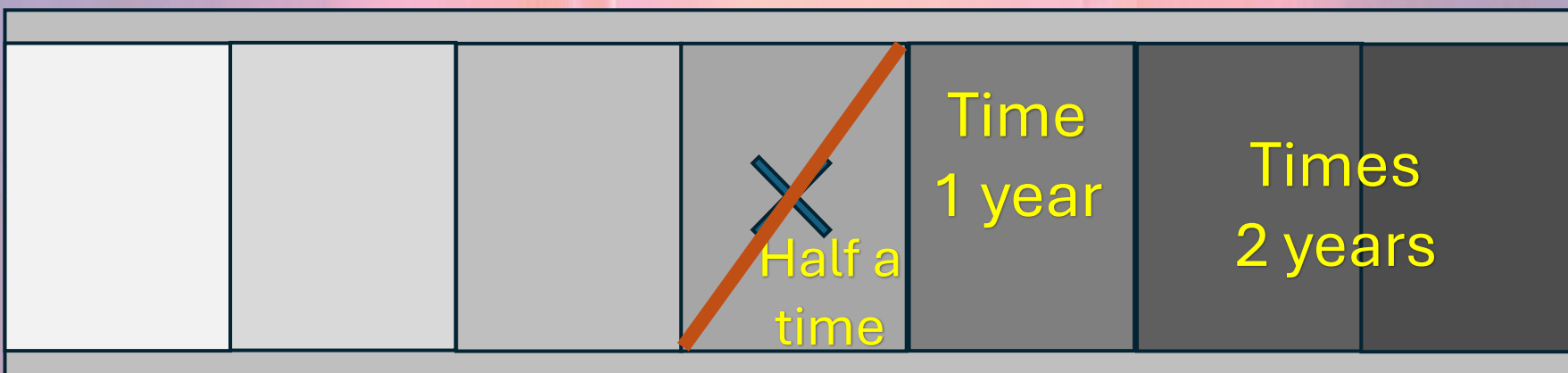
Jesus' Second Coming
