**Revelation 1:13-15** And standing in the middle of the lampstands was someone like the Son of Man. His feet were like polished bronze refined in a furnace, and

**his voice thundered like mighty ocean waves.**

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

<sup>NLT</sup> **Revelation 4:1** Then as I looked, I saw a door standing open in heaven, and the same voice I had heard before spoke to me **like a trumpet blast.**

The voice said, "Come up here, and I will show you what must happen after this."

**Revelation 4:3-5** The one sitting on the throne was as brilliant as gemstones -- like jasper and carnelian. And the glow of an emerald circled his throne like a rainbow.

<sup>5</sup> From the throne came flashes of lightning and **the rumble of thunder**

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 4:6-8** In front of the throne was a shiny sea of glass, sparkling like crystal. In the center and around the throne were four living beings...

Day after day and night after night they keep on saying,

"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God, the Almighty -- the one who always was, who is, and who is still to come."

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 5:2** And I saw a strong angel,  
who shouted with a loud voice:

"Who is worthy to break the seals on this scroll and open it?"

**Revelation 5:4-5** Then I began to weep bitterly because no one was found worthy to open the scroll and read it. <sup>5</sup> But one of the twenty-four elders said to me, "Stop weeping! Look, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the heir to David's throne, has won the victory. He is worthy to open the scroll and its seven seals."

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 5:7-9** *THE LAMB* took the scroll from the right hand of the one sitting on the throne. 8 And when he took the scroll, the four living beings and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb. Each one had a harp, .... And they sang a new song with these words: "You are worthy to take the scroll and break its seals and open it. For you were slaughtered, and your blood has ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation."

Revelation 5:13 And then I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and in the sea.... They sang: "Blessing and honor and glory and power belong to the one sitting on the throne and to the Lamb forever and ever."

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 6:1-2** As I watched, the Lamb broke the first of the seven seals on the scroll. Then I heard one of the four living beings say with a voice like thunder, "Come!" I looked up and saw a white horse standing there.

**Revelation 6:9-10** When the Lamb broke the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of all who had been martyred for the word of God and for being faithful in their testimony. <sup>10</sup> They shouted to the Lord and said, "O Sovereign Lord, holy and true, how long before you judge the people who belong to this world and avenge our blood for what they have done to us?"

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 7:1-3** Then I saw four angels standing at the four corners of the earth, holding back the four winds so they did not blow on the earth or the sea, or even on any tree. <sup>2</sup> And I saw another angel coming up from the east, carrying the seal of the living God. And he shouted to those four angels, who had been given power to harm land and sea, <sup>3</sup> "Wait! Don't harm the land or the sea or the trees until we have placed the seal of God on the foreheads of his servants."

And I heard how many were marked with the seal of God -- 144,000 were sealed from all the tribes of Israel.

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 7:9-12** After this I saw a vast crowd, too great to count, from every nation and tribe and people and language, standing in front of the throne and before the Lamb. They were clothed in white robes and held palm branches in their hands. <sup>10</sup> And they were shouting with a mighty shout, "Salvation comes from our God who sits on the throne and from the Lamb!"

<sup>11</sup> And all the angels were standing around the throne and around the elders and the four living beings. And they fell before the throne with their faces to the ground and worshiped God.

<sup>12</sup> They sang, "Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom and thanksgiving and honor and power and strength belong to our God forever and ever! Amen."

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 8:1** When the Lamb broke the seventh seal on the scroll, there was **silence throughout heaven for about half an hour.**

<sup>2</sup> I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and they were given seven trumpets.

**Revelation 8:5-6** An angel filled the incense burner with fire from the altar and threw it down upon the earth; and **thunder crashed,** lightning flashed, and there was a terrible earthquake. <sup>6</sup> Then the seven angels with the seven trumpets prepared to blow their mighty blasts.

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 8:7-10** The first angel blew his trumpet, and hail and fire mixed with blood were thrown down on the earth.

<sup>8</sup> Then the second angel blew his trumpet, and a great mountain of fire was thrown into the sea.

<sup>10</sup> Then the third angel blew his trumpet, and a great star fell from the sky, burning like a torch.

**Revelation 8:12-13** Then the fourth angel blew his trumpet, and one-third of the sun was struck, and one-third of the moon, and one-third of the stars, and they became dark. <sup>13</sup> Then I looked, and I heard a single eagle crying loudly as it flew through the air, "Terror, terror, terror to all who belong to this world because of what will happen when the last three angels blow their trumpets."

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 9:1-3** Then the fifth angel blew his trumpet, and I saw a star that had fallen to earth from the sky, and he was given the key to the shaft of the bottomless pit...locusts came from the smoke...

**Revelation 9:9** their wings roared like an army of chariots rushing into battle.

**Revelation 9:13-14** Then the sixth angel blew his trumpet, and I heard a voice speaking from the four horns of the gold altar that stands in the presence of God. <sup>14</sup> And the voice said to the sixth angel who held the trumpet, "Release the four angels who are bound at the great Euphrates River."

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 10:1-4** Then I saw another mighty angel coming down from heaven, surrounded by a cloud, with a rainbow over his head. His face shone like the sun, and his feet were like pillars of fire.  
<sup>3</sup> And he gave a great shout like the roar of a lion. And when he shouted, the seven thunders answered. <sup>4</sup> When the seven thunders spoke, I was about to write. But I heard a voice from Heaven saying, "Keep secret what the seven thunders said, and do not write it down."

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 10:5-7** Then the angel I saw standing on the sea and on the land raised his right hand toward heaven. <sup>6</sup> He swore an oath in the name of the one who lives forever and ever, who created the heavens and everything in them... He said, "There will be no more delay." <sup>7</sup> When the seventh angel blows his trumpet, God's mysterious plan will be fulfilled. It will happen just as he announced it to his servants the prophets."

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 11:3** : And I will give power to my two witnesses, and they will be clothed in burlap and will prophesy during those 1,260 days.

**Revelation 11:12** Then a loud voice from Heaven called to the two prophets, "Come up here!" And they rose to Heaven in a cloud as their enemies watched.

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 11:15-19** Then the seventh angel blew his trumpet, and there were loud voices shouting in heaven: "The world has now become the Kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ,<sup>1</sup> and he will reign forever and ever."

<sup>16</sup> The twenty-four elders sitting on their thrones before God fell with their faces to the ground and worshiped him. <sup>17</sup> And they said, "We give thanks to you, Lord God, the Almighty, the one who is and who always was, for now you have assumed your great power and have begun to reign. <sup>18</sup> The nations were filled with wrath, but now the time of your wrath has come. It is time to judge the dead and reward your servants the prophets, as well as your holy people, and all who fear your name, from the least to the greatest. It is time to destroy all who have caused destruction on the earth."

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 11:19** Then, in heaven, the Temple of God was opened and the Ark of his covenant could be seen inside the Temple. Lightning flashed, **thunder crashed and roared**, and there was an earthquake and a terrible hailstorm.

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 12:1-2** ...a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon beneath her feet, and a crown of twelve stars on her head. <sup>2</sup> She was pregnant, and she cried out because of her labor pains and the agony of giving birth.

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 12:7-9** Then there was war in heaven. Michael and his angels fought against the dragon and his angels. <sup>8</sup> And the dragon lost the battle, and he and his angels were forced out of Heaven. <sup>9</sup> This great dragon -- the ancient serpent called the devil, or Satan, the one deceiving the whole world -- was thrown down to the earth with all his angels.

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 12:10** Then I heard a loud voice shouting across the heavens, ....now...."It has come at last!!! -- salvation and power and the Kingdom of our God, and the authority of his Christ. For the accuser of our brothers and sisters has been thrown down to earth.

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 13:1** ... a beast rising up out of the sea...

**Revelation 13:5** the beast was allowed  
to speak great blasphemies against God. And he was given  
authority to do whatever he wanted for forty-two months.

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 14:1-3** Then I saw the Lamb standing on Mount Zion, and with him were 144,000 who had his name and his Father's name written on their foreheads.

<sup>2</sup> And I heard a sound from heaven like the roar of mighty ocean waves or the rolling of loud thunder.

It was like the sound of many harpists playing together.

<sup>3</sup> This great choir sang a wonderful new song in front of the throne of God and before the four living beings and the twenty-four elders.

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 14:6-9** an angel flying through the sky, carrying the eternal Good News to proclaim to the people who belong to this world -- to every nation, tribe, language, and people. <sup>7</sup>

"Fear God," he shouted. "Give glory to him. For the time has come when he will sit as judge. Worship him who made the heavens, the earth, the sea, and all the springs of water."

<sup>8</sup> Then another angel followed him through the sky, shouting, "Babylon is fallen -- that great city is fallen -- because she made all the nations of the world drink the wine of her passionate immorality."

<sup>9</sup> Then a third angel followed them, shouting, "Anyone who worships the beast and his statue or who accepts his mark on the forehead or on the hand must drink the wine of God's anger."

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 14:13** And I heard a voice from Heaven saying, "Write this down: Blessed are those who die in the Lord from now on. Yes, says the Spirit, they are blessed indeed..."

**Revelation 14:15** Then another angel came from the Temple and shouted to the one sitting on the cloud, "Swing the sickle, for the time of harvest has come; the crop on earth is ripe."

**Revelation 14:18** Then another angel... came from the altar. He shouted to the angel with the sharp sickle, "Swing your sickle now to gather the clusters of grapes from the vines of the earth, for they are ripe for judgment."

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 15:1-4** Then I saw in Heaven.... what seemed to be a glass sea mixed with fire. And on it stood all the people who had been victorious over the beast and his image and *the* number of his name. They were all holding harps that God had given them. <sup>3</sup> And they were singing the song of Moses and the song of the Lamb: "Great and marvelous are your works, O Lord God, the Almighty. Just and true are your ways, O King of the nations. <sup>4</sup> Who will not fear you, Lord, and glorify your name? For you alone are holy. All nations will come and worship before you, for your righteous deeds have been revealed."

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 16:1** Then I heard a mighty voice from the Temple say to the seven angels, "Go your ways and pour out on the earth the seven bowls containing God's wrath."

**Revelation 16:17-18** Then the seventh angel poured out his bowl into the air. And a mighty shout came from the throne in the Temple, saying, "It is finished!"

<sup>18</sup> Then the thunder crashed and rolled, and lightning flashed. And a great earthquake struck -- the worst since people were placed on the earth.

**Revelation 16:21** There was a terrible hailstorm, and hailstones weighing seventy-five pounds fell from the sky onto the people below. They cursed God because of the terrible plague of the hailstorm.

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 18:1-2** After all this I saw another angel come down from heaven with great authority, and the earth grew bright with his splendor. <sup>2</sup> He gave a mighty shout: "Babylon is fallen -- that great city is fallen!"

**Revelation 18:4** Then I heard another voice calling from Heaven, "Come away from her, my people. Do not take part in her sins, or you will be punished with her."

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 18:9-11** And the kings of the world - will **mourn** for her as they see the smoke rising from her charred remains. <sup>10</sup> They will stand at a distance, terrified by her great torment.

**They will cry out,** "How terrible, how terrible for you, O Babylon, you great city! In a single moment God's judgment came on you."

<sup>11</sup> **The merchants of the world will weep and mourn** for her, for there is no one left to buy their goods.

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 18:17-19** And all the captains of the merchant ships and their passengers and sailors and crews will stand at a distance.

<sup>18</sup> They will cry out as they watch the smoke ascend, and they will say, "Where is there another city as great as this?"

<sup>19</sup> And they will weep and throw dust on their heads to show their grief. And they will cry out, "How terrible, how terrible for that great city! The shipowners became wealthy by transporting her great wealth on the seas. In a single moment it is all gone."

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 18:21-22** Then a mighty angel picked up a boulder the size of a huge millstone. He threw it into the ocean and shouted, "Just like this, the great city Babylon will be thrown down with violence and will never be found again.

<sup>22</sup> The sound of harps, singers, flutes, and trumpets will never be heard in you again. No craftsmen and no trades will ever be found in you again.

The sound of the mill will never be heard in you again.

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 19:1-5** After this, I heard what sounded like a vast crowd in heaven shouting, HALLELUJAH!!!! Salvation and glory and power belong to our God. <sup>2</sup> His judgments are true and just. He has punished the great prostitute who corrupted the earth with her immorality. He has avenged the murder of his servants."

<sup>3</sup> And again their voices rang out: HALLELUJAH!!!! The smoke from that city ascends forever and ever!"

<sup>4</sup> Then the twenty-four elders and the four living beings fell down and worshiped God, who was sitting on the throne.

They cried out, "Amen! HALLELUJAH!!!!!"

<sup>5</sup> And from the throne came a voice that said, "Praise our God, all his servants, all who fear him, from the least to the greatest."

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 19:6-7** Then I heard again

what sounded like the shout of a vast crowd

- like the roar of mighty ocean waves

- like the crash of loud thunder: "HALLELUJAH!!!!"

Praise the LORD! For the Lord our God, the Almighty, reigns. <sup>7</sup> Let us be glad and rejoice, and let us give honor to him. For the time has come for the wedding feast of the Lamb, and His bride has prepared herself.

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 20:6** Blessed and holy are those who share in the first resurrection. For them the second death holds no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with him a thousand years.

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 20:7-15** Satan will be let out of his prison. <sup>8</sup> He will go out to deceive the nations, gather them together for battle -- a mighty army, as numberless as sand along the seashore, fire from heaven came down on the attacking armies and consumed them. <sup>10</sup> **Then the devil, who had deceived them, was thrown into the fiery lake of burning sulfur, joining the beast and the false prophet. There they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.** <sup>11</sup> **And I saw A GREAT WHITE THRONE and the ONE sitting on it.** The earth and sky fled from his presence, but they found no place to hide. <sup>12</sup> I saw the dead, both great and small, standing before God's throne. And the books were opened, including the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to what they had done, as recorded in the books.....  
<sup>15</sup> **And anyone whose name was not found recorded in the Book of Life was thrown into the lake of fire.**

**Revelation 21:1-2** I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the old heaven and the old earth had disappeared. And the sea was also gone. <sup>2</sup> And I saw the holy city, the new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven like a bride beautifully dressed for her husband.

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 21:1-2** I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the old heaven and the old earth had disappeared. And the sea was also gone. <sup>2</sup> And I saw the holy city, the new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven like a bride beautifully dressed for her husband.

**Revelation 21:3-5** I heard a loud shout from the throne, saying, "Look, God's home is now among His people! He will live with them, and they will be His people. God Himself will be with them. <sup>4</sup> He will wipe every tear from their eyes, and there will be no more death or sorrow or crying or pain. All these things are gone forever." <sup>5</sup> And the One sitting on the throne said, "Look, I am making everything new!" And then he said to me, "Write this down, for what I tell you is trustworthy and true."

# Hear the Sounds of the Prophecy

**Revelation 22:6-9** Then the angel said to me, "Everything you have heard and seen is trustworthy and true. The Lord God, who inspires his prophets, has sent his angel to tell his servants what will happen soon." <sup>7</sup> "Look, I am coming soon! Blessed are those who obey the words of prophecy written in this book."

<sup>8</sup> I, John, am the one who heard and saw all these things. And when I heard and saw them, I fell down to worship at the feet of the angel who showed them to me. <sup>9</sup> But he said, "No, don't worship me. I am a servant of God, just like you and your brothers the prophets, as well as all who obey what is written in this book. Worship only God!"

**Revelation 22:17-21** The Spirit and the bride say, "Come."

Let anyone who hears this say, "Come."

Let anyone who is thirsty come. Let anyone who desires drink freely from the water of life.
